He led Canaan's investment in Lending Club (NYSE:LC), now a multibillion dollar company, as the company's first institutional investor and continues to serve on the company's board. He has also led Canaan's investments in point of sale cloud platform ShopKeep, moving marketplace Bellhops and B2B marketplace JOOR, investment marketplaces CircleUp, Bumped, Orchard and healthy dog food company Ollie.

Dan joined Canaan after serving as Chairman and CEO of Shopping.com, where he led the company from zero to over \$100 million in revenue in five years. Dan took Shopping.com public in 2004 and it was acquired by Ebay in 2005 for \$620 million.

Dan was also chairman of the Internet Lab, a US-Israeli incubator for early-stage consumer Internet startups, as well as Senior VP of MasterCard International, where he managed all online global debit products.

Dan earned an A.B. from Princeton University's Woodrow Wilson School of Public and International Affairs and an M.B.A. from Yale University. Dan also spent two years running a UNHCR program on the Thai-Cambodian border. In addition to his investment activities at Canaan, he is a member of the Advisory Board for the Yale School of Management, an advisor to Silas Capital and Sadara Ventures and a board member of Hand in Hand, a bilingual Jewish Arab school program currently operating in 6 Israeli cities.
